Calls for Service and Reports example: Automated Report



- Information will be available to Crime Prevention for the purpose of providing information about calls for service and reports taken during any selected time period for a specific apartment community.
- Data within the report:
 - <u>Calls for service</u>: to the property but may or may <u>not</u> have generated a report.
 - <u>Reports taken:</u> generated report from a validated crime that occurred.
 - <u>CFS by hour</u>: the time of day when crimes may be occurring.
 - <u>CFS by source</u>: initiated by Officer vs Initiated by public.
 - <u>CFS by type:</u> breakdown by type over designated time period.
- Ada County Crime Mapper- website resource (link in PowerPoint presentation)
 - You can filter the information that you want to see including:
 - Report number
 - Type of Call
 - Date
 - Police Agency
 - Arrest Yes/No
 - You can export or print the data for your reference or to assist in documentation for possible eviction process.
 - An Ada County resource and should include data from:
 - Ada County Sheriff's Office (included Kuna, Eagle, and Star)
 - Meridian Police Department
 - Boise Police Department
 - Garden City Police Department
 - Additional Online Resources:
 - Idaho Court Repository
 - icourt.idaho.gov/
 - Ada County Arrests
 - adacounty.id.gov/sheriff/arrests-inmates-warrants/

- Online Records resources Meridian Police website:
 - Make payments: parking, public records request
 - Make a police report: no-suspect information
 - Public Records Request Form: online
 - you can also email directly to records@meridiancity.org or complete a records request form in person at both station lobbies.
- Per Idaho code, Records has 3-10 business days to respond to a public records request.
- The more information you have the quicker it can be attended to:
 - Case/DR#, victim/suspect name, dates of birth, incident address, incident dates, or times.
- Typically, NO charge, unless it requires more than 2 hours' time or more than 100 pages.
- Property managers are considered to be (3rd party requester). Some information may be heavily redacted.
- **If an officer leaves a business card, try contacting the officer first, they may be able to provide more details regarding the incident sooner than the records request process.
- If you are requesting for an eviction process, a lawyer can subpoen athe records which will also contain more information than a 3rd party requestor.
- All mental hold cases will be denied to 3rd party requestors.
- Juvenile information is almost always redacted/ unavailable but can depend on circumstances or status of the case.
- Q: Is a security company employee considered 3rd party?
 - A: If you are named in the report as a "reporting party" or "person with knowledge" you would be an authorized agent, and therefore would be provided more information in the report.
